
CAMP TAW'S TOP INTERVIEW TIPS



Let's Do this!

BE ON TIME

Be ready at least 10 minutes prior to your interview time. If Camp TAW doesn't contact you within 5 minutes of the time, reach out to them to confirm. It also helps to find a quiet, private, well-lit place, free from possible interruptions. Place your phone and other electronics in silent mode. The goal is to minimize ALL distractions.



CHECK YOUR TECH AHEAD OF TIME

Your employer wants social cues that you are engaged in the conversation and actively listening. This can only be done with functioning technology.

DRESS TO IMPRESS




BE PREPARED
